

Dear Patients,

With the rising concern for the spread of Coronavirus (Covid-19), I would like take this opportunity to make all our patients aware of the advanced sterilization practices already in place in our offices, as well as added precautions in light of the current health climate.

Our dental practice adheres to the highest OSHA-mandated standards for sterilization and infection. This includes three levels of instrument sterilization, maximum use of disposable (single use) protective barrier materials, and continual surface sterilization and disinfection.

In addition, we incorporate additional measures such as office air ionization which electrostatically filters bacteria, viruses, mold, and other airborne particulate matter with negative ions and UV light. Our offices strive to use the most natural and non-toxic sterilization and disinfection materials including the use of many antibacterial and antiviral essential oils (e.g., clove, lemon, eucalyptus, tea tree, rosemary, and peppermint among others).



We are also now incorporating and offering a new chemical-free sanitizing device for use by patients in our office. PurLite, a new UV technology which incorporates a patented UV-C light, eliminates 99.9% of all bacteria and viruses, including coronavirus, in 20 seconds. It is available, complimentary, to our patients and can sanitize phones, keys, pens and personal items which are often a carrier for a variety of pathogens including viruses, bacteria and mold. Recently, I have been asked to join the consulting team for PurLite to help develop additional applications specific to biological dentistry.

Finally, most doctors and scientists agree that the best deterrent to any human exposure to pathogens is a strong and healthy immune system. Optimal oral health is a key component to an optimal immune system with corresponding systemic health and wellness. Our bodies are fighting disease every day. The elimination of toxicity and inflammation in the mouth and the restoration of proper function are foundational for our bodies to be able to defend itself against disease, self-regulate and heal.
